For how long time the nordic people have been knitting mittens are unknown. The earliest sign of mitten knitting dates back to the 13th century.

This mitten is inspired by the Viking Age and the worldtree Yggdrasil. Even the birds who foretold "Ragnarök", can be seen in the pattern of these gloves, hidden in the naturally deep colors.
